International Learner Medical Insurance Information

All Non-EEA students are required to have private medical insurance when coming to and residing in Ireland for the purpose of study. The private medical insurance should provide cover for accident and/or disease and should cover the student for any period of hospitalisation.

From 2nd October 2020, Students in Ireland enrolled on a course that is more than 12months duration must buy private health insurance. Students can buy private health insurance specifically designed for international students from the following providers.

Medical insurance is a requirement for graduates on the Third Level Graduate Scheme (Stamp 1G or 1A) which must include hospital cover and a minimum of €25,000 for Accident and €25,000 for Disease.
