### **Learner Emergency Procedures and Contact Details**

All CCT learners are made aware of Emergency Procedures, in the Learner Handbook which is issued to each learner with the College at the beginning of each academic year. The Emergency phone number to call in case of emergency, is a 24/7 available mobile number.

In the interests of learner welfare, CCT provides a subsidised medical service in partnership with a medical clinic in Dublin, a referral system through a relationship with fully qualified Counselling Psychologists (with the first six sessions fully subsidised by CCT). The Emergency contact facility is in place, to help ensure student safety. This is a 24/7 number, and learners who are in an emergency and who require assistance from CCT, can contact the Emergency number.

The number is available to enrolled students and can be located in the Student Handbook. This phone is manned constantly on a rotated basis among CCT Student Services staff.

The Emergency number is for emergency calls only. For example, this facility can be used to report events on campus such as fire, medical emergencies, suspicious or criminal activities, or personal events off campus where any learner needs to report an emergency of their own.

CCT reminds all learners that the national Emergency numbers in Ireland to call are 999 and 112. 112 works also in all EU countries and from any phone, free of charge.
